

## MNSW Charity Ride Day backed by a second day of riding

Following the cancellation of its first-ever **Call To Arms Recreational Charity Ride Day** last month, the rescheduled event is set to take place at this Saturday at **Lakes MCC, Awaba**. However, for those looking to get as much track-time as possible and for those traveling from interstate, Lakes will now open its gates for a second day of riding on the Sunday.

Realizing that a lot of riders are preparing to travel from interstate to take part on the day, Lakes club has worked tirelessly with MNSW to creating a weekend of riding for all - details are as follow:

### **Saturday 24th July**

Day one will take place as the first-ever Recreational Charity Ride Day, supporting the Cancer Council and Call To Arms, with all proceeds going to the Cancer Council.

The day is open to all riders - no race licence or club membership required (\$25 rec. licence applies for non-MA licence holders) and will feature timed free-sessions on the Lakes track for MX'ers and Quads.

There will also be jumping castles and food and drink stalls available for all the family and is designed as a fun day out - all for a good cause. Yellow Call To Arms armbands will be available for anyone wishing to take part in the Cancer Council promo!

Entry is just \$30 for an early pre-paid entry or just \$40.00 to rock up and ride on the day. Additional bikes just \$15.00 and all riders who nominate a marshal for a round of riding will receive a \$5.00 discount.

(Junior riders are to supply log books.)

### **Sunday 25th July**

Given the number of riders and interest - both locally and interstate - Lakes will open its gates again on Sunday for a Club Practice day. Again, the day will run on timed sessions per-class, with food and drink available as well.

Entry is just \$25.00 for juniors and \$30.00 for seniors - however, club memberships will apply and will be available on the day.

Both days will get underway at approximately 8:30am.

MNSW's first-ever Recreational Charity Ride Day is set to kick-off a new-era of rider-related events and activities and we look forward to seeing you all there for an enjoyable day in the day.
