SUBJECT : **Parade Laps**

At the most recent meeting of the Motorcycling NSW Board, the Directors instructed the office to release a memorandum reminding all clubs, Stewards and Clerk of Course that any parade lap held during a permitted meeting in NSW must be included upon the permit application and listed upon the permit.

Further, any rider participating in a parade lap must wear a helmet that complies with the standards outlined in the Manual of Motorcycle Sports. Failure to do so will void the conditions of the permit and thus, potentially expose the Steward appointed to legal action in the event of injury or accident.

The Steward of the meeting must not alter the terms of the permit.

In the event a club wishes for a parade lap to be conducted without riders wearing helmets, the club or Steward must seek approval in writing from MNSW who will make the alteration to the permit upon issue should it be approved.
