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**SUBJECT** : Medical Clearances

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Motorcycling New South Wales would like to remind all clubs and Key officials that medical clearances may be accepted at any permitted race meeting or event. The medical clearance presented must state that the injured rider is “fit to resume motorcycle racing or activities” the doctor’s provider number must be printed on the medical clearance. Clearances that state’s fit to resume “normal duties” or “return to work” cannot be accepted. The suspended riders list is emailed to all clubs every Friday afternoon. The riders name on the medical clearance should match the name on the suspended riders list. The medical clearance should be attached with the required after meeting records and returned to Motorcycling NSW. The required after meeting paperwork along with the medical clearance is to be submitted to Motorcycling NSW within 5 working days from the date of the event.

A sample of an acceptable medical clearance is displayed below:


