SUBJECT : Junior Coaching Program Logbooks
(Interstate Rider's requirements)

In NSW the Junior Coaching Program specifies that all riders from the age of 4 to under 16 years must have, in their possession, a Motorcycling Australia licence and a logbook before they can participate at any permitted event.

In other states and territories in Australia, junior riders only require a logbook from age 7 to under 16. This has caused some confusion when riders come from interstate to ride at events in NSW.

Riders whose licence lists an interstate address and are under 7 years of age who wish to participate in a NSW event do not need to have a logbook or sign a declaration to participate, but must have a current Motorcycling Australia licence.

Please Note: This exemption only exists for riders whose licence has an address from another state.

NSW riders must have a current Motorcycling Australia licence and show a logbook or sign a declaration for any rider aged under 16 years before they can participate in any event.
