



MEMORANDUM

TO: ALL CLUBS

RE: NSW ST JOHN AMBULANCE

We refer to previous correspondence in the above matter and advise that MNSW and St John Ambulance recently conducted a review of first aid arrangements. St John Ambulance NSW will no longer cover the following **senior meetings** where those events are to be held more than **15 minutes** (by road transport) from a hospital unless an agreement to do so has been reached between MNSW and St John Ambulance. In effect this means:

- ◆ Motocross;
- ◆ Dirt Track; and
- ◆ Speedway.

Clubs wishing to continue utilising St John Ambulance personnel to cover such events are required to submit a written request to the MNSW Office. Details of the club's track distance from the nearest hospital and the availability of NSW Ambulance Service to cover meetings should be addressed in the request. Clubs are also to provide a summary of the cases transported to hospital from the meeting venue for each type of event conducted over the past five (5) years and thereafter provide an annual summary. Each Club will be assessed on an individual basis.

Where the track falls within the 15 minute transport range or alternatively where approval has previously been granted to Clubs whose tracks fall outside of the said transport range, we confirm that the following qualifications for St John Ambulance Officers are suitable:

St John Ambulance will continue to provide first aid for Enduro and Minikhana meetings together with Junior meetings including Motocross, Dirt Track, and Speedway on the following basis:

- M1 - Able to intubate, insert chest drain, insert IV cannula and administer IV drugs.
