**SUBJECT : ONE EVENT LICENCES FOR JUNIORS**

We have recently received a number of enquires regarding the issuing of One Event Licences to riders under the age of 16 at race meetings.

We take this opportunity to clarify the procedure to alleviate any misconception.

Riders under the age of 16 years wishing to purchase a One Event Competition or One Event Recreational Licence must produce their Junior Coaching Program Logbook to be eligible to acquire the licence.

Please note that producing a Kick-Start booklet or conducting the Kick-Start Program on the day is not considered satisfactory to purchase a One Event Licence.

Juniors/Nippers who complete the Kick-Start Program can apply for a Logbook through the MNSW office at no charge. A Junior Logbook Application form can be found at [www.motorcycling.com.au](http://www.motorcycling.com.au).

We request that all clubs, officials and riders become familiar with the above requirement to ensure the integrity of the system is not diluted and that riders can expect the same standards are applied by all affiliated clubs in relation to this issue.
