SUBJECT : ONE EVENT LICENCES – JUNIORS/NIPPERS

We take this opportunity to remind all recipients of the policy pertaining to junior/nipper riders purchasing One Event Licences.

To purchase a One Event Licence, a junior/nipper must present their Junior Coaching Program Logbook to the key officials of the meeting.

Junior logbooks are stamped in the “Record of Coaching” section indicating the date the logbook was issued to the rider.

Similar to all junior/nipper twelve month licence holders, those wishing to purchase a One Event Licence must have five hours of compulsory coaching entered into their logbook within twelve months of the date the logbook was issued.

Any rider whose logbook has been issued for more than twelve months and cannot demonstrate an entry in the logbook showing they have actually carried out their five hours coaching **cannot** purchase a One Event Licence.

All junior/nipper riders who currently have a logbook but not a twelve month MA Licence have been reminded of this via a direct mail-out.

SUBJECT : ONE EVENT LICENCES

We take this opportunity to remind all junior/nipper riders who have a logbook and wish to purchase a One Event Licence that under the rules of the Junior Coaching Program it is compulsory for all juniors/nippers to complete five hours of coaching each twelve months until they are a senior.

If your logbook has been issued for more than twelve months (the issue date is stamped on the inside in the “Record of Coaching” section) you are required to present to the key officials of the meeting that you have completed the five hours coaching to be able to purchase a One Event Licence on the day of the event you wish to participate in.

Any rider who **cannot** show that they have completed the five hours coaching will **not be allowed**, by the key officials of the meeting to purchase a One Event Licence, if twelve months has passed since the logbook was issued.

All clubs have been notified of the above and will adhere to this process.

Riders can send a copy of their logbook to the MNSW office, showing the five hours coaching, thus enabling us to update your record of coaching on our computer database. This may alleviate any problems in the event of your logbook being lost.
