SUBJECT: Missing Equipment – Round 1 NSW Motocross Championships

It is with disappointment that I report the theft of medical equipment from the first round of the NSW Motocross Championships held at Clarence on the 23rd, 24th & 25th April 2011.

The equipment is expensive and vital for the ongoing service provided by Southcare medical to the sport.

The theft has been reported to the police with those responsible facing a maximum of 5 years jail term for stealing medical equipment. Included and stolen with the equipment were various medications (drugs) that if administered incorrectly could cause serious harm. The theft of the medications alone can carry a 2 year jail term.

Should the items be returned to Motorcycling NSW intact, no further questions will be asked and the matter will be dropped.

This is extremely disappointing as this will only contribute to the increased cost of medical services which will be passed on to the rider, thus increasing the cost to participate.
