SUBJECT : OFFICIAL OF THE YEAR

As many of our members would be aware it is nearly time for the 2010 Night of Champions. This night is designed to award our State Champions and runners up on their achievements throughout the 2010 racing year and to say a thank you to many of our officials and clubs who have been awarded throughout the year for their efforts.

One of the awards that will be presented on the night will be the ongoing "Official of the Year" award. In 2010 MNSW is calling for nominations for the Official of the Year from members and clubs. If any club or member wishes to nominate an Official for "Official of the Year" please complete the attached nomination form and return it to the MNSW Office. This nomination MUST be endorsed by the President of the club whom the nominee is a member of before it will be accepted at the office. Clubs, please feel free to distribute this form to members.

It is a requirement that the person nominated for Official of the Year have held an active officials licence throughout 2010 and also been an active official at race meetings and events throughout the year. Officials who have not been active in that capacity will not be considered for Official of the Year.

Once received, the nominations will be reviewed by the Board of Directors and a short list will be chosen. The short list will be determined by what is written in the nomination, the "Official of the Year" award is not a ballot, and the person who receives the most nominations will not necessarily make the short list. Those Officials who make the short list will be notified in writing and invited to attend the 2010 Night of Champions where the winner will be announced.

Nominations for Official of the Year are due in no later than 5.00pm, Tuesday 19th October 2010. Any nominations received after this date cannot be accepted.
