By reducing the cost of Friday's practice by \$30 for competitors entering the Barry Sheene Festival of Speed, it is hoped that a greater number of riders will take advantage of this generous offer.

The cost of practise on Good Friday has now been reduced to \$120 for pre-paid or \$150 for those who enter on the day.
