**SUBJECT : SPEEDWAY COMPETITORS LOG BOOK**

Motorcycling NSW Limited have been given a directive from Motorcycling Australia that as from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006 under the 2006 Manual of Motorcycle Sport, it is now compulsory for all Speedway competitors, both junior and senior, to have a current edition of the Speedway Competitors Log Book.

### *Speedway :*

#### *10.8.4 Log Books*

##### *10.8.4.1*

*Each competitor must possess a prescribed log book which must:*

- (a) Be produced by the competitor at scrutineering.*
- (b) Be available for production at any other time during the meeting*
- (c) Contain provision for the following entries:*
  - i) The meeting date and place.*
  - ii) The scrutineers report as to any defects or faults in the machine*
  - iii) Any penalties imposed by the Referee.*

##### *10.8.4.2*

*being*

*A competitor must correct any machine defects noted in the log book before permitted to compete on that machine again.*

Please be aware that as of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2007, the old competitor log books will not be accepted therefore we encourage all competitors to update their log books when renewing their competition licence for 2007. The new log books are now available from the MSNW Office at a cost of \$5.50.
