Not only did we have the youngest rider to ever ride at an Australian Trials Championship meeting (shout out to Kurt Coleman who is 4 years old), but we also had a few extra talented riders showing Australia that NSW riders will always go hard for the win.

We'd like to congratulate all the riders on their efforts, but special mentions go to:

Kyle Middleton who won his 5<sup>th</sup> Australian Open Solo Championship. This is the first time a rider has won 5 consecutive Aussie Titles, and came just one week after Kyle led the Australian Men's Team to first place in the International Class at the Trials des Nations in Spain.

Kristie McKinnon who won her 8th Australian Women's Trials Championship.

Luke Anderson who won the Masters Class, with Martin O'Connor 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Peter Curtis who claimed 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Veterans 60+ class.

Bev Anderson won the Master Women's class, with Julie Collins 2<sup>nd</sup> and Deena O'Connor 3<sup>rd</sup>.

And to Murray Collins and Mark Patterson who were the first NSW Sidecar entry at an Australian Championship since 1996. They finished a very creditable 6<sup>th</sup>.

## DEFIBRILATOR GRANT

Hopefully all of our club contacts received an email from their Regional Sport & Event Officers a few weeks ago regarding a NSW Sport & Recreation Grant Application that is currently open to local sporting clubs. The Local Sport Defibrillator Grant Program is to assist Sporting Clubs across NSW to purchase and maintain an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED). An AED is a life saving device and the grant is a great opportunity for Club's to get some financial assistance to have an extra level of safety for their members and riders.

The closing date for the Grant Applications is the 20<sup>th</sup> of December 2017 so make sure to find out all the information from <https://sport.nsw.gov.au/clubs/grants/defibrillator> and get your applications in by then.

## 2017 COMING TO AN END

We don't know where the time has gone but we are almost at the end of the Year! We ask that all Clubs keep in mind that the MNSW Office will close over the Christmas period. This means that any permits needed for December 2017 & January 2018 be sent to the Office well in advance of the Christmas Closure. All 2017 outstanding paperwork must also be returned to the Office prior to the end of the Year.

If your riding licence is due to expire at the end of December/early January and you will need to use it in January - you will be able to renew your licence Online.

The easiest and quickest way to do this is via Ridernet using your licence number (Ridernet ID). Go to [www.motorcycling.com.au](http://www.motorcycling.com.au) and click 'Current Member Login'.
